Incident/Accident Form

If in doubt fill out! Check out the Fact-Information Sheet posted on the CUPE 997 web site – www.cupe997.ca – Member Resources – Fact-Information Sheets – Incident/Accident Reporting.

As per Feb 12 08 Kerrie Wright Memo to Principals, Vice Principals and Secretaries – “For your clarification, incidents of student aggression (biting, scratching, kicking, etc.) towards staff must be reported by completing an Incident / Accident Report and subsequent Principal Investigation Report, even when there is no lost time or medical treatment. Please make your staff aware of this reporting requirement.”

Safety Concern Form..... should you have a Health & Safety concern that has been identified and has not been resolved – there is a Procedure and form which should be completed. The Principal/Supervisor is responsible for responding, in writing, to your concern. This information is forwarded to the Members of the Joint Health & Safety Committee and should your concern not be addressed this issue then comes forward to the Committee for discussion and possible recommendation to the Board.
